9- Please explain about the town/village that you choose, the location, the condition.

9. P First: The Capital Municipality: The following areas were targeted:
- I I- The Old City of Sana'a:
The old city of Sana'a is located in the center of the capital, Sana'a, and it is one of the archaeological areas, and it is a region inhabited by people of all social groups and from multi-population governorates who do not have areas for agriculture to obtain food because the area is urban. Most of the population depends on the salaries that the state disburses, but it has stopped since the outbreak of the conflict in 2015. Families depend on emergency aid from relief organizations to obtain food and livelihoods, but the aid has decreased due to the lack of support for the organizations, which has caused a number of families to become malnourished due to the lack of food and its diversity. The region is also currently experiencing a major humanitarian disaster as a result of torrential rains and torrents. Which threatens a large number of families to lose their homes due to the inability of the people to maintain them, as ancient homes are threatened with collapse.
- 2- - Bani Al Hareth area :
It is located in the northern part of the capital, Sana'a, and many displaced families from the epileptic areas of Saada and Amran, in northern Yemen, have flocked to it. Most of the families in the region do not have a steady source of income, no agricultural lands or businesses. They mainly depend on aid provided by relief organizations. Many families are headed by women. Therefore, families face many difficulties in obtaining food or obtaining work commensurate with the social status of women. In the community .
- 3- The displaced camp on Al Khamseen Street is considered
It is located in the southeast of Amanat Al Asimah, the site consists of many displaced families from the conflict areas. They mainly depend on aid of relief organizations and do not have any source of income to support the family.
- O Second: Sana'a Governorate
- I I- Iblas area:
The area of Ablas is the separating area between Sana'a and the governorates of Amran and Al Mahwit from the west. The region witnessed the displacement of many families from the conflict areas, especially from Al Hudaydah and Amran governorates. The area is also witnessing urban expansion through random construction for the purpose of leasing to the displaced. The region lacks a number of services. The most important of them is that there is neither a government hospital nor a medical center despite the high population density, especially with the recent increase in the last four years. The area has not been targeted by relief organizations.
- 2- qa'a Aleera :
It is located in the north of Sana'a in Hamadan district. A number of displaced families have come to the area from Amran governorate, according to the local authorities, and families faces a natural disaster due to the loss of their agricultural crops as a result of locust swarms, floods and torrential rains.

- a. What kind of disaster that has ever happened in the area? How was the condition of the people after disaster? (eg., conflict, hunger problem, natural disaster like flood, drought, etc):

The region has been facing an armed conflict since 2015 as a result of the civil war in Yemen. The conflict has left thousands of families displaced to multiple areas, including the areas targeted in the project in the Amanat Al-Asimah and Sana'a governorate. How many targeted areas witnessed the displacement of many families due to the destruction of their homes as a result of the torrential rains and the explosion Small and medium dams.

The war is still going on, in addition to the exposure of many homes and refugee camps to destruction due to the heavy rains and torrents that Yemen has not previously witnessed.

- b. How big was the loss?

The area was subjected to a large wave of displacement from conflict areas in Amran, Saada and Hodeidah. Families lost their livelihoods and their surrounding community and migrated to a host community, which led to overcrowding and high rental houses and high prices due to the absence of government control. According to the organization's monitoring of the displaced families in the Ablas area, with approximately 1100 families A displaced woman is displaced from Amran, Saada, and Hodeidah. Floods, torrential rains, and the explosion of dams also caused the magnitude of the loss. Many families lost their homes and agricultural crops because they were swept away by the torrents. There is no comprehensive statistics for the families affected by the torrents for the month of August, but we monitored some families during the distribution of sacrifices.

- c. **What natural disaster potentials that can be happen?**

If the heavy rains continue, many water dams that are overcapacity may explode, such as the Rownah dam in the Hababa area, which exploded during our distribution of sacrifices in the Iblas area to which the dam's torrents reached, and the road was cut off as shown in the pictures and videos attached to the report. Many of the houses inhabited by the displaced are subject to demolition due to the heavy rains and torrential torrents, as the structures inhabited by the displaced are random and poor, with water seeping in from everywhere and on the roofs.

10. Please explain if the location has special humanitarian case

- a. How is the condition of the public economy (profession, amount of income, physical house condition, unemployment level)?

The host community mostly works in agriculture and livestock care, especially in the Iblas and qa'a Aleera areas sana'a. As for the Capital Municipality, they mainly depend on salaries, but they have been cut off since the beginning of the 2015

conflict. No one gets any salary anymore. Average household income per day is equivalent to two to three Dollar (1200 Yemeni riyals). Most of the families that were targeted live in small houses, 2 rooms, a bathroom, and a small kitchen, in random houses suffering from water leakage resulting from the rain. They depend on the water of the fountain provided by philanthropists to vulnerable families, since the price of a white water sometimes reaches 15 thousand Yemeni riyals, equivalent to 25 There is also no sanitation in the Iblas area and the bottom of the trench. The level of unemployment is high, equivalent to 1 in every seven people who have a job, for several reasons, the most important of which is the armed conflict in Yemen and instability, as well as the Corona pandemic, which has made many families lose their jobs.

- b. Has there ever been a social conflict (racial or religious)? What was the cause and how was it solved?

There is no social conflict at the present time.

- c. How is the people's health condition (disease outbreaks, infant malnutrition)? If there is, what was the disease and how many infants suffered from malnutrition?

The health status of people in the targeted areas is poor due to the outbreak of many diseases, including occasional malnutrition, and chronic diseases such as heart and lung diseases, diabetes, etc. The number of malnourished children is 87 infected cases in Ablas area, Sana'a governorate. In the Qaa al-Ara area, the number of malnourished children whose families were targeted for sacrifice is 86 cases.

- d. How is the people's social condition?

The social condition of people is relatively poor due to the absence of social solidarity among members of society and weak morals.

- e. Has there ever been food insecurity (crop failure)? And how much is the frequency of meat consumption for the community per month?

Yes, there is a significant lack of food security, especially with the expectation of salary disbursement and business interruption due to the Corona pandemic, which has reduced the level of family income, which has negatively affected the level of food access and the type of nutrition. The targeted families are looking for their day's sustenance from basic food and are no longer able to diversify their food And you buy meat because of its high price, which brings the price of a kilo of mug meat to 6000 Yemeni riyals, equivalent to 10 US dollars. And the price of a kilo of beef is between 3500 to 4500 Yemeni riyals, equivalent to 5.8 to 7.5 US dollars. Most vulnerable families are waiting empty-handed. Patience holds wed dings, celebrations and events to eat meat.

Most vulnerable families eat chicken meat at a rate of 4 times a month. As for goat and cattle, they consume it in wedding and social occasions.

- f. Is there urbanization? How it influences the local people?

There is no urbanization in the targeted areas, rather it is characterized by randomness.

Urban expansion is done randomly without planning or authorization by the state, as there is no sanitation and paved roads, so when rain and torrential rains turn up the alleys and streets and the homes (pits for the disposal of human waste) explode.

- g. How is the condition of children, teenagers, and women (percentage of single motherhood and juvenile delinquency)?

According to the testimony of Aqal, the people and the local authority indicated that the percentage of adolescents who practiced thefts and non-moral acts exceeded 45% of the total number of adolescents, and the population was no longer secure in their needs.

- II. What is your suggestion about what we can do in the future at this location? And kindly explain the reason:

- Distribution food baskets or vouchers due the high need

The targeted areas suffer from severe food shortages, as they are not targeted by relief organizations, according to the testimony of the people and the mind. The families also need to satisfy, as a minimum, 3 consecutive distributions for each family every month, so that families can devote themselves to searching for work or livelihoods.

- Support the livelihood to generate work opportunities

Families in the targeted areas need to support livelihoods because most of the families are displaced from the conflict areas, which have lost their sources of income and become in a new society. They need a long time to fit in and integrate. Therefore, they need projects that allow families to obtain job opportunities and generate income.

- Support refugees with medicines and treatment

According to the testimony of the health unit in the Ablas region, it faces an acute shortage of medicines, especially for chronic diseases, and nutritional supplements for malnourished children. They also need displaced families to expand the health unit to a health center to expand the capacity of the injured and sick. Please write down any other comments (optional)
