The project has an impact on saving the lives of children and pregnant women from the specter of starvation by activating the voluntary work in the community awareness on the side of food and health through the selection of the team of health volunteers who conduct continuous visits to follow up the targeted cases and continue to raise awareness and education . Using this structured mechanism that helps malnourished children to recover quickly and to grow naturally and provide them with adequate nutrition at all phases until January next year as one of the most important needs to build the health of all children and their families .The eradication of starvation is one of the most important globally . Which focuses on the importance of full nutrition for human health and development, making nutrition attention one of the most important factors in the fight against poverty globally . As well as the decrease in the monthly mortality rate in the targeted areas due to food insecurity improving the security situation , social , psychological stability of the community , the search for opportunities to live in the case of health of the body , mind capable of thinking , and working .

The project will continue to influence the target community by continuing to raise awareness among volunteers to develop the child , their mothers , and the community in which they live, where the educational achievement improves and the child grows, especially focusing on children under five years .

Improve the nutrition of 72 children and their families from the specter of starvation by providing food security in targeted areas for 3 months	By contracting with health volunteers from the target areas and then fielding the volunteers in order to select the children according to entry criteria for forms of malnutrition and acceptance criteria in the treatment phase (attached copy of the register) and provide them with the necessary nutrition materials and where the volunteers continue to follow cases throughout the project until there Improving their health status, and then documenting and disseminating media coverage in local newspapers and news sites	Include 72 children and their families in the treatment program and follow up according to the project plan until next January, so that they can be ok .

From the beginning , as soon as the first payment arrived. Sanid Organization was keen to ensure the successful implementation of the project according to the plan . We are happy to implement this project . Which aims to improve the nutrition of children and their families from the specter of starvation which is being implemented in partnership with ACT . Through our observation, we found that the areas targeted urgently need urgent interventions in the field of food and all life-saving interventions .

After reviewing the results achieved it is clear that the project achieved a good success rate and achieved many of the expected results, and there are positive results achieved because of continuous follow-up and preparation and processing according to planned plans, and also helped the interaction of target groups and their desire to learn and benefit, which was observed through their interaction .
