Introduction

Water and food in addition to providing in-kind and social assistance and supporting an ambition in accordance with its strategic plan to turn to development work to implement sustainable humanitarian projects, women's empowerment and food security with great flexibility in the country's exceptional circumstances as a result of the war and blockade. In June, Sand Relief and Development distributed 90 food baskets to 90 families, which were targeted by the poorest families and displaced families in the region with funding from Usman, and the components of the basket were: (25 kilos white flour, 10 kilos of rice, 10 kilos of sugar, 4 liter oil, 2kg milk, 2kg food salt, 2kg food salt, 2kg Passing at a total cost of 2467026 Yemeni riyals

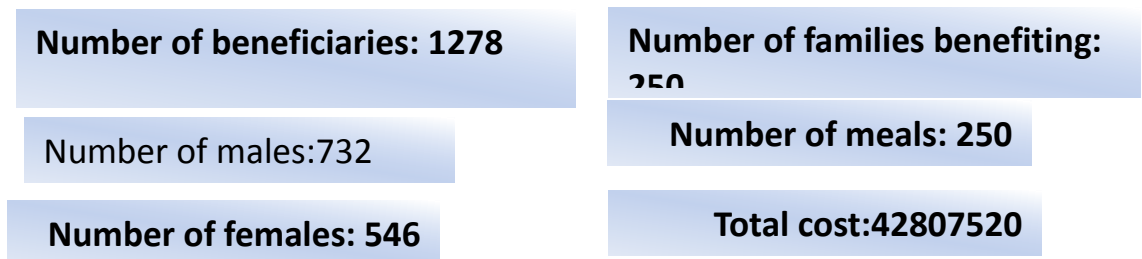

Distributing ready meals to a number of (250) families of poor and displaced families in capital DC for 10 days, where the total cost (2807520) Yemeni riyals.

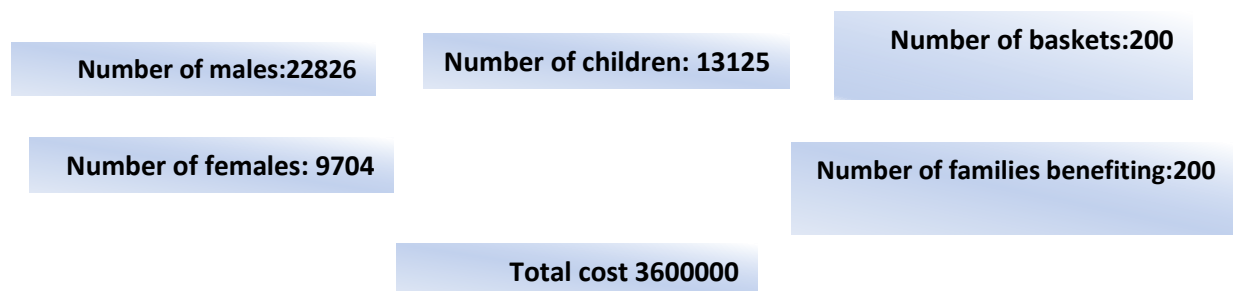


4- Al-Hodeidah Displaced people Relief Project

In July, Sanid organization for Relief and Development distributed food baskets consisting of half a bag of flour, 10 kilos of sugar, 10 kilos rice and 4 liters of oil .

Household items consisting of mattresses, blankets, kitchen utensils, 250 families from Hodeidah governorate, in the capital's secretariat, benefited from the project .

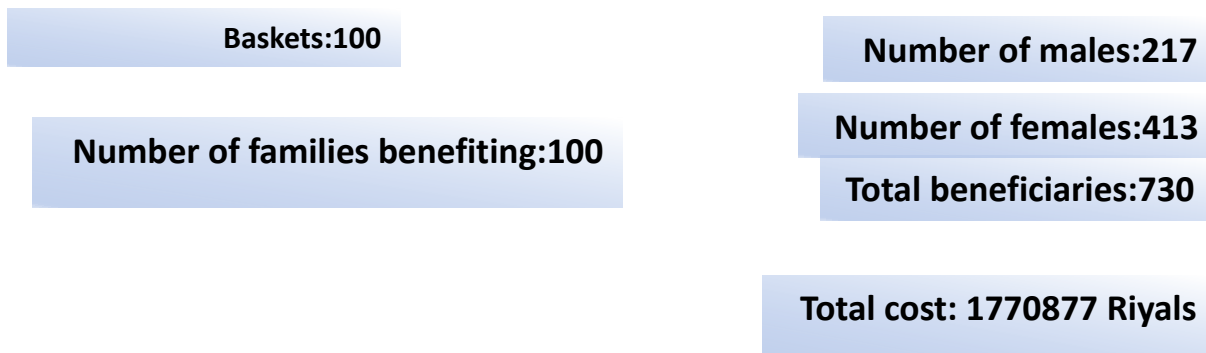

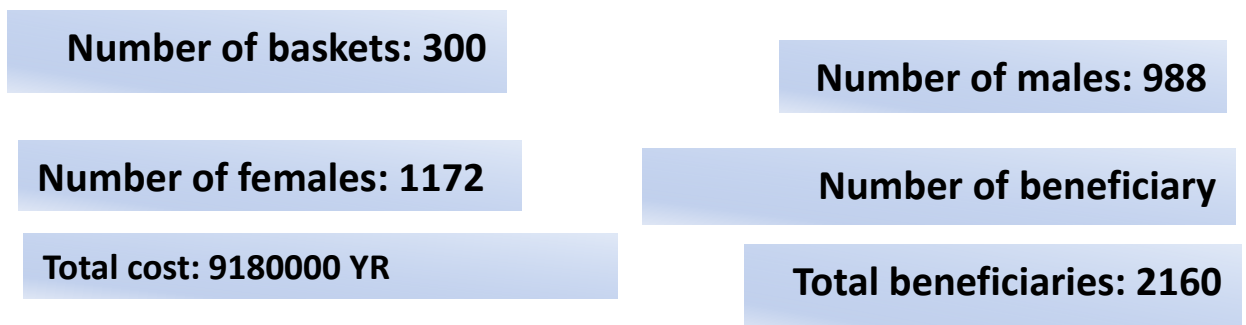
8- Food basket distribution project in Bani al-Harith Directorate (Jidar)

9- Food basket distribution project in Sana'a governorate

In November, Sand Relief and Development, funded by THE ACT of Indonesia, distributed 300 food bags (half a bag of flour, 10 kilos of sugar, 10 kilos of rice, 4 liters of oil + salt + dates + beans) to 300 families of the poorest families and displaced people from Hodeidah province in Um It is the capital in the directorate of Bani al-Harith area of Jidar and at a total cost of (9180000) Yemeni riyals



10- Food basket distribution project, Directorate of Al-Epitheli, Ibb Governorate

In November, Sand Relief and Development, funded by THE ACT of Indonesia, distributed 200 food bags consisting of half a bag of flour, 10 kilos of sugar, 10 kilo rice, 4 liters of oil, on 200 families of the poorest and displaced families from Hodeidah governorate in Al-Beheir district, Ibb governorate .At a total cost: 14075261) Yemeni riyals

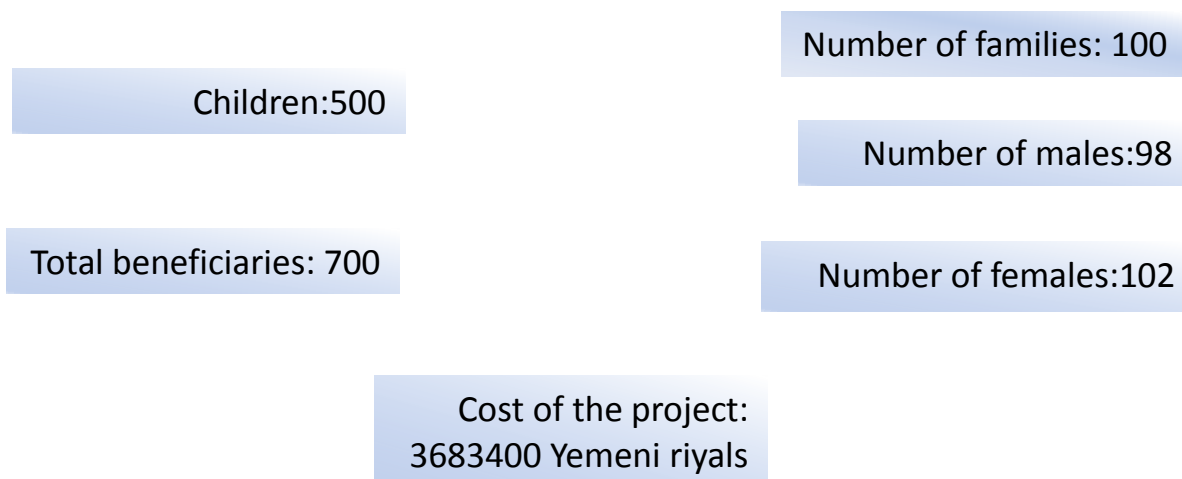
Third: Field of Health

1- Emergency Response Project in the Field of Child Phase II (Reducing Malnutrition)

To complete the implementation of the second phase of the project, which began its first phase at the end of 2017, Sanid organization for Relief and Development, funded by the Indonesian ACT organization, and in partnership with the Ministry of Health and Population of the Ministry of Health and Bani Hashish in Sana'a governorate, implemented the distribution of food baskets to families suffering Her children are malnourished as well as nutritional supplements for malnourished children under the Ministry of Health standard. The project targeted 100 children with supplements

(Nutrients + vitamins + pembinat) after the examination in accordance with strict health procedures through a group of doctors and health workers working in this field and 100 food baskets were distributed to the families of children in the number of 100 families.

And at a total cost of 3683400 Yemeni riyals



Awareness was also carried out through health centers of the Ministry of Health after strict procedures for injured children in the Area of saifan.

The implementation of a training course for mothers of the target children on how to prevent malnutrition and how to use and appointment of child-departing supplements.

Sanid also targeted training and awareness sessions for a number of women in the Hamedan Directorate in the field of the prevention of diphtheria and cholera, as well as health (educational) programmes. implemented by the organization.

2- The project of treatment assistance for chronic patients:

With funding from The Yemen Organization, treatment assistance for chronic patients (diabetes, stress, kidneys) has been distributed to 50 displaced and poor patients in the capital secretariat .

1- Water project

- Preparing and preparing to receive the delegation of the British company Usman, which will visit Yemen in early 2019 to implement a number of humanitarian projects.
